*The Cold War at Home* Aug 25 2022 One of the most significant industrial states in the country, with a powerful radical tradition, Pennsylvania was, by the early 1950s, the scene of some of the fiercest anti-Communist activism in the United States. He also stresses the deep roots of the state's militant anti-Communism, which can be traced back at least into the 1930s.
