Twenty days after the violence practiced by the German Gebirgsjäger on the military of the Acqui Division in Kefalonia another crime for the same reason was committed on the island of Kos by the Grenadiers of the 22nd Division of General Müller: 103 Italian officers were shot because Badogliani and, therefore, traitors.
