Hans Willer Bentinck, 1st Earl of Portland (1649-1709) was the close confidant of William III and arguably the most important politician in Williamite Britain. post-Revolution Britain with political events in the Netherlands. It also analyses Anglo-Dutch political relations during the crucial period of the Nine Years War, Britain's first major commitment to a continental war since the sixteenth century. In so doing it connects Dutch and British historiography and significantly contributes to our understanding of British politics during the 1690s, both domestically and within an international context.
