El Capítulo 2 de la tesis examina la relación entre las rentas del petróleo y el gas y diferentes indicadores de educación. El Capítulo 3 analiza los efectos de las rentas de los recursos naturales tanto en la cantidad como en la calidad del capital humano. Además, encontramos que el impacto negativo que las rentas de recursos naturales tienen en la educación se modera en países con calidad de instituciones por encima del cierto umbral. El Capítulo 3 analiza empíricamente los efectos de los recursos naturales tanto en la cantidad como en la calidad del capital humano. Se emplea un panel de 162 países para el período 1996-2014, lo que permite confirmar el papel crucial de las instituciones. Los resultados muestran que la asociación negativa entre los recursos naturales y el capital humano puede revertirse si la calidad de las instituciones es lo suficientemente alta. El análisis también considera diferentes tipos de recursos naturales y enfatiza la importancia de usar un indicador que incorpore la cantidad pero también la calidad del capital humano. Los resultados muestran que las rentas de los recursos se asocian negativamente con el capital humano ajustado por la calidad, y este efecto negativo puede estar mediado por la calidad de las instituciones. Además, los resultados demuestran que este efecto adverso depende del tipo de rentas; la alta dependencia de las rentas del petróleo es en particular la que parece dañar el capital humano. Finalmente, el Capítulo 4 analiza la relación entre los shocks de precios de los productos básicos y la desigualdad, considerando un panel de 80 países desde 1990 hasta 2016. Este capítulo analiza si los diferentes tipos de shocks de precios de los productos básicos afectan la desigualdad a través de diferentes canales (costo de oportunidad o efectos de rapacidad). Los resultados muestran que shocks positivos de precios de los productos básicos tienden a aumentar la desigualdad. Sin embargo, los shocks de precios afectan la desigualdad en diferentes direcciones dependiendo del tipo de producto básico. Los shocks positivos de precios de productos básicos no agrícolas aumentan la desigualdad, y esto parece ocurrir debido a un aumento en la desigualdad en la rentas de capital (sugiriendo efectos de rapacidad). Además, este hallazgo parece más fuerte cuando el nivel inicial de desigualdad es alto y / o la calidad de las instituciones es baja. Este es el caso de muchos países de África subsahariana y Latinoamérica.

**The Gumilev Mystique** Oct 28 2022 Since the collapse of the Soviet Union, the legacy of the historian, ethnographer, and geographer Lev Nikolaevich Gumilev (1912–1992) has attracted extraordinary interest in Russia and beyond. *Cancers in People with HIV and AIDS* Dec 18 2021 The association between AIDS and cancer was recognized from the beginning of the AIDS epidemic, when the appearance of Kaposi sarcoma in a cluster of young men was one of the first signs of this new disease. It was soon recognized that AIDS was caused by infection with a novel virus (HIV) and that AIDS patients are prone to develop a number of "AIDS-defining" cancers: Kaposi sarcoma, lymphoma, and cervical cancer. The development of effective combination anti-HIV therapy starting around 1996 converted AIDS from a death sentence to a manageable disease and led to dramatic shifts in the epidemic. As this therapy was able to improve immune function in patients, the incidence of most "AIDS-defining" cancers decreased. There is a misconception, however, that AIDS has gone away. In fact, as AIDS patients are living longer, the number of AIDS patients has more than doubled in the United States since 1996, and the AIDS population overall has increased in age. Also, as AIDS patients are less likely to die of other complications, cancer is coming to the forefront as one of the most common causes of death in regions where AIDS drugs are widely available. Moreover, the three "AIDS-defining" cancers are now taking a back seat to a number of other HIV-associated cancers, such as Hodgkin lymphoma, lung cancer, and anal cancer. In the developing world, AIDS-associated cancers are a major public health problem, and in some regions of sub-Saharan Africa, Kaposi sarcoma is the most common tumor in men. In recent years, there has been a vast increase in our understanding of HIV-associated cancers. We now know, for example, that most are caused by other viruses and that the main role of HIV and immunodeficiency is to provide a supportive environment for the viruses to multiply and for the cancers to develop. But there remain a number of unanswered questions and a need for improved prevention and therapy. In the 28 chapters of this book, written by some of the most renowned experts in this field, we present up-to-date information on the cancers associated with HIV infection. The chapters cover the epidemiology of these cancers, their pathogenesis, their clinical presentation, and their treatment. Resource status for Northern Shrimp and Striped Shrimp in SFA 4 was updated based on Northern Shrimp Research Foundation (NSRF)-DFO summer trawl survey data (2005-14). Trends in fisheries performance were inferred from total allowable catch (TAC), commercial catch to date, fishery catch per unit effort (CPUE) and fishing patterns.
