Instead, our main findings are intended to stimulate discussions about available options for the industry. By examining the entire SSS fleet operating in the Mediterranean, Black Sea and Portuguese core ports, we hope to portray a general picture of the most convenient technological options for different kinds of vessels. In addition, we hope to draw attention to the factors explaining most of the uncertainty over future results and provide useful information for both ship owners and policy-makers who may be evaluating policies to foster the adoption of the technologies that are most environmentally friendly and contribute the most to the competitiveness of the shipping and shipbuilding sectors in Europe. Financial feasibility and cost-benefit analyses for

the conversion of each vessel deployed in short-sea services in the studied area have been validated with the collaboration of prominent industrial companies.
