You do not have to have read the previous Dakonian books (Darak, Aton & Caid). The world powers, in league with a group known only as the Black Ghost, develop super soldiers called Cyborgs to stop the world from total self-annihilation in the nuclear age, but they didn't ask for the Cyborgs' feelings in the matter.
