These permanent departments of many city governments across America established a new profession I call "Waterwork." A high achievement of this new calling in which I had a hand, as did many wonderful, able professionals, and famous individuals whom I hope to give adequate tribute to, was the establishment of the International Swimming Hall Of Fame at Fort Lauderdale, Florida, USA.
