He did not undergo surgery to correct his condition because he cannot take blood transfusions due to his religious beliefs. Purple Rain is a variation of the Long Island Iced Tea and another cocktail with almost the same ingredients as the current Purple Rain. The blue curacao and the grenadine give this cocktail its distinct purple color. When drizzled after the cocktail has been mixed with the blue curacao, the gradual sinking of the grenadine into the cocktail evokes the imagery of a strong rain.
