As the Mesoamerican Long Count Calendar ends on December, 21 in 2012, many people suggest this date marks the end of the world or of human civilization. It is of a certain interest that already in the early twentieth century Yeats was concerned

with this kind of apocalyptic worldview. "The Second Coming" therefore is one of the poems that also represents his understanding of the apocalypse, which is not comparable to those who believe in the prophecy of the Mayan calendar. "For him, the apocalypse is always connected with genuine spiritual revelation [and] with vision," as it is the literal translation of the Greek word (Howes, Kelly 2006: 52).
