If witness identification is correctly implemented, investigators and prosecutors can make their judgments effectively, and focus their resources more efficiently. everyone's interest to make the best use of the memory of witnesses: to preserve it without changing it; to render it maximally accessible; to provide an environment in which witnesses feel free to report their recollections; and to accurately assess the probable validity of the witness's report, regardless of the witness's certainty or doubts about its accuracy.
