Railway Reform and Charges for the Use of Infrastructure Feb 16 2022 European railways are undergoing far-reaching reform to foster competition and promote the development of international freight and passenger services. Separation of infrastructure management from train operation is at the heart of the reform and requires the introduction of charges for the use of the network. Integration of European markets should provide great opportunities for rail to grow. This ECMT report sets out how barriers to growth arising from differences in the way trains pay to use national networks can be overcome. It recommends moving to a set of simple charges for freight that create similar incentives for the management and planning of train operations across borders. Decisions on the structure of charges are constrained by the way in which competition is designed to develop under national and European transport policies. The report examines the way charges can be structured differently in different parts of the rail market - suburban passenger services, inter-city services, high speed trains, domestic and international freight etc. - to increase cost recovery and maximise the financial stability of infrastructure managers without damaging the development of competition. The recommendations have been taken up by the European Union through its Committee on Developing

European Railways.
