Jones) delivered me into a world where your food was always fried and everyone we knew was Black and a Baptist. I was Lucky number "4" of 9 children, five girls and four boys. We children didn't know it, but we were not wealthy. The world that my parents built for us was secure as any palace, so filled with warmth and affection. The four-bedroom dwelling, with a covered front porch was located in the west section of town, about two blocks from St. Peters Baptist Church. Our Sunday started early.
